2. Meeting Teachers

5. Milk Term 1

6. Healthy Eating

Our school has in place a Healthy Eating Policy which encourages children to eat either fruit, vegetables, bread snacks and milk or water at break time. We would encourage you as parents to continue as much as possible the promotion of good eating habits when preparing lunches for the children. Children are

also permitted to **bring water**, which they can drink during class time. Research has shown that when dehydration occurs children find it difficult to concentrate and the drinking of water helps them to focus more in the afternoon.

7. Uniform Labels

Could you please ensure that all uniforms are clearly labelled with your child's name, so as to avoid confusion if items of clothing are misplaced. This also includes PE clothing and coats.
