1. New Intake 2020-2021 School Year

Primary 1 Children Sept 2020

If your child is 4 on or before 1st July 2019 then he/she is due to attend school in Sept. Applications are now able to be made. This can be accessed via our school website under 'Our School - Apply for P1' or via the EA website. The Education Authority (EA) process goes live on **Tuesday 7th January 2020 at 10.00am**. The closing time and date for punctual applications will be **12.00 midnight on Friday 31st January 2020**.

Parents will have the opportunity to amend their submitted application until the closing date. This replaces the current paper based application form.

For admission to the forthcoming academic year, parents will continue to provide their child's birth certificate and any other verifying documents stipulated in admission criteria directly to the first preference provider / school.

2. Transfer Children

Most Secondary and Grammar Schools will be holding their 'Open Nights' in the coming months. Information for these will usually be posted in the local press. 'Open Nights' are designed to help you and your child, make informed decisions about the school selection process by giving you the opportunity to speak to the Principals, teachers and pupils of the relevant schools. 4. Breakfast Club

This will begin next Monday 20^{th} January from 8.00 am to 8.45am during term time, Monday to Friday. It is open to children of school going age. The children get a healthy breakfast when they arrive and get a chance to relax before a hard day's work. If a family wishes to use the service they are required to commit to using the service for a full year, a minimum of 3 days a week. The service costs £2 per child per day covering the cost of employment of staff, food and equipment. A 2^{nd} and 3rd family member will be £1 each. The initiative is none profit.
